On November 19, 2020, Toyobo Co., Ltd. announced updates to previous disclosure concerning the fire at the Inuyama Plant.

In relation to the fire that occurred at the company's Inuyama Plant on September 27, the information clear as of November 19 is set out below. If, in future, the company comes to expect that the fire will have a significant impact on its earnings, it will promptly disclose that.

#### Location of the fire

Toyobo Co., Ltd. Inuyama Plant, Inuyama, Aichi Prefecture

#### Date and time of the fire outbreak, and developments

- ▷ September 27, 9 p.m.: A fire started at the Inuyama Plant's film production line
- ▷ September 28, 1 a.m.: The public fire department announced that it had brought the fire under control
- ▷ September 28, 7 a.m.: The public fire department announced that it had extinguished the fire

#### Damage

- ▷ Casualties: Two dead (company employees), one injured (company employee; already back to work)
- ▷ Property damage: Packaging film manufacturing facility and some of the production equipment at the Inuyama Plant.

#### Cause of the fire and preventive measures

Local fire and police authorities have completed their on-site inspections.

#### Impact on product shipments

Shipping resumed on September 30, with the exception of some products.

#### Operations at the Inuyama Plant

From October 1, the company began a phased resumption of operations of production equipment for which it had obtained approval for use from relevant government authorities, upon confirming safety. As of November 19, all production equipment was in operation except for the equipment damaged by the fire.
